Welcome to the 60th Anniversary Season of The Three Hundred Club, the oldest continuously-active Contest in Sport! The Germain Glidden Bowl is up for grabs once again.

The 300 Club Ballot Deadline is, as always, the second Monday in May. This year it's **MONDAY, MAY 10.**

For 2010, we repeat our popular "two-fer new Member" offer: any Member who signs up two new Members for 2010 plays free and saves the 2010 Membership dues! As always, our dues are \$50 for returning Members, and \$50 plus a one time Initiation Fee of \$25 for new Members.

As we all know, each year one or two active or returning Members miss the Deadline. There's nearly always somebody who gets busy or forgets and is left disappointed. We really want to prevent this in 2010. So we urge all Members (and new Members) to do the following **ASAP!!**

First: *Please, oh please,* go to the Website, log in, and update your personal info, including your email and mailing addresses. We cannot communicate with the Membership without accurate info! Follow the instructions or call us if you forgot your login/password. We **NEVER** release Membership info.

Second: The Balloting section on the Club Website (see bottom) is now open. We urge you to enter a Ballot **NOW**. It's been shown that once that's done, Members tend to remember to make final choices by the Deadline and not forget. You can make changes to your Ballot up 'til Midnight of the Deadline Date just by logging in and clicking on your Ballot. Payment isn't due until the Deadline. We advise that you pay dues now so your Ballot can be ranked. (Before May 10, only you can see your picks).

Third: Show the Site to your friends! They too can register on the Site easily, and select a Ballot, which they too can change or use as they wish. Remember, Ballots are only activated, calculated, and ranked after payment is received, so there's no charge if someone fills out a Ballot and later decides not to play (although we can't imagine why!).

Fourth: MARK YOUR CALENDAR NOW! The 2010 Balloting Deadline is Midnight, Monday, May 10. Enclosed in this mailing is an annoyingly-colored nuisance reminder you can tape to your computer monitor. We will send out email reminders from time to time as the Deadline draws near.

We hope all will play in 2010. We welcome active, returning, and new Members, and we look forward to the Weekly Winners, the Midseason Winners, the "Perfect Ballot," the individual contest Winners, and the Grand Prize Winner at season's end. May yours be the best Ballot --after mine!
